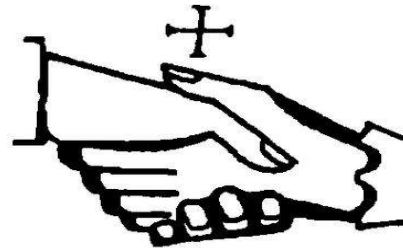

Blintz Souffle By [Jamie Geller](#)

INGREDIENTS

- *10 to 12 frozen blintzes, assorted flavors, defrosted just enough to separate*
 - * 1 cup sour cream*
 - * ¼ cup sugar*
 - * 4 eggs, beaten*
 - * 2 tablespoons butter, melted*
 - * 2 teaspoon pure vanilla extract*
 - * 1/8 teaspoon salt*
 - * 1 tablespoon cinnamon sugar*
- Additional sour cream, for serving (optional)*

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Preheat oven to 350° F.*
- 2. Place blintzes in a 9 x 13-inch pan.*
- 3. In a medium bowl, mix together sour cream, sugar, orange juice, eggs, butter, vanilla and salt. Pour mixture over blintzes.*
- 4. Sprinkle with cinnamon sugar.*
- 5. Bake, uncovered, at 350° for 45 minutes, until puffed and golden. Serve with sour cream on the side, if desired.*
